

OUR WINES

Lasseter Family wines are crafted in an old world style, an expression of John and Nancy's love of France: its beauty, grape varieties and blended wines. These artisan wines are made from organic grapes grown on the family's estate vineyards in Sonoma Valley. There are five wines in the Lasseter Family Winery portfolio, each with a proprietary name and a story to tell:

ENJOUÉ (Joyful; Playful)

A rosé blend of estate-grown Syrah, Mourvèdre and Grenache grapes crafted in the style of the dry rosé wines of Provence and Bandol. It is reminiscent of wines enjoyed in Europe's terrace cafés and the perfect companion to a leisurely afternoon in the sunshine.



A red blend in the Southern Rhône style with a focus on Grenache. Fruit forward and food friendly, this wine evokes memories of the Lasseters' relaxing train travel through France and the old world blends enjoyed on their journeys.

L'AME DU SAGE (Soul of the Wise Man)

An old vine Zinfandel, this is made in the classic field blend style developed by the European immigrants who brought winemaking to California. The name pays homage to the century-old vines that produce this unique blend. Available at the winery only.

PAYSAGE (Landscape Painting; Countryside)

A Bordeaux-style blend of Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Malbec. A meticulously blended wine with full-bodied complexity, this is a true demonstration of the winemaker's art.

AMOUREUX (Lovers)

A Bordeaux-style blend made primarily of Malbec and Cabernet Sauvignon. John and Nancy were first introduced to Malbec on their honeymoon in Sonoma County, and this wine commemorates that discovery.
