Noir, Dundee Hills (\$38) Tangy berry fruit; savory and edgy with bright, earthy style; complex and balanced on the finish.

Rutherford (\$70) Deep flavors of plum, blackberry and spice; tangy, balanced and complex with style and considerable finesse.
