### 91 Lasseter Family Winery 2015 Enjoué,

Sonoma Valley (\$28)

Smooth, lush and juicy with dry, mellow flavors of sunny Rhône varieties; made by Nancy and John Lasseter (head of Pixar) in the Glen Ellen region of Sonoma. 70% Syrah, 18% Mourvedre, 12% Grenache.



#### 92 Lasseter Family Winery 2012 Amoureux,

Sonoma Valley (\$64)

A lush blend that is mostly Malbec; smooth and dense with blueberry, plum and spice; deep and rich with lovely balance and tangy flavors. 73% Malbec, 17% Cabernet Sauvignon, 8% Merlot, 2% Cabernet Franc.



#### 91 Lasseter Family Winery 2013 Chemin de Fer,

Sonoma Valley (\$56)

Smooth, spicy with bright blackberry and plum; lush, smooth and dense; long and balanced. 60% Grenache, 23% Mourvedre, 17% Syrah.



#### 92 Lasseter Family Winery 2012 Reminiscence,

Sonoma Valley (\$125)

Dark and velvety smooth; ripe plum, juicy style with supple, balanced flavors; rich and deep with good length.
80% Cabernet Sauvignon, 15% Merlot, 5% Cabernet Franc.

**91** Lasseter Family Winery 2014 Voilà, Sonoma Valley (\$46) A lovely use of the underutilized Semillon in combination with Sauvignon Blanc and Musqué; smooth, creamy, lush and subtly influenced by oak; showing notes of fig and citrus with fine balance. 50% Semillon, 29% Sauvignon Blanc, 21% Sauvignon Musqué.
