



Lasseter Family Winery Visitor Policy

For the safety of our guests and employees, Lasseter Family Winery has introduced the following requirements for visitors. By entering our facility, you agree to abide by the following directives, as well as any verbal instructions provided by our employees, to ensure a safe and enjoyable environment for all.

We are pleased announce the return of indoor tastings at Lasseter Family Winery! We continue to offer Vineyard Tours and outdoor tastings on our scenic Patio. Vineyard Tour and Patio reservations are dependent upon weather and may be cancelled or rebooked due to inclement weather.

For indoor tastings, we currently accommodate groups of eight or fewer (this includes those in your group who may not be tasting). To ensure the highest level of health and safety for our guests and staff, **for ALL indoor tastings** we now require that **guests provide proof of vaccination before being seated.**

If you are unable to provide proof of vaccination prior to being seated for an indoor tasting, we will do our best to arrange for a Vineyard Tour or seat you on our Patio, subject to availability.

Guests must refrain from visiting if they have tested positive for COVID-19 within the last 10 days, have a fever, or have other COVID-19 symptoms. Guests who are currently experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19 must not enter our facility. These symptoms may include cough, fever over 100.4 degrees, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, chills, muscle pain, sore throat or recent loss of taste or smell.

Guests are asked to wash and/or sanitize their hands upon arrival as well as after sneezing, blowing their nose or using the restroom. Sanitizer, soap, and water are readily available.

Employees have the right to refuse or end service to any guest exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19 while at our facility. If you are asked to leave our facility for this reason, we appreciate your understanding and immediate attention to this request.
